#### Week 1 - From Me to We 1 Timothy 1:1 - 2:6

#### What is Worship?

- Adoration—we give God praise.
- Instruction—we hear God's Word.
- Prayer—we intercede for others.
- Confession—we seek God's forgiveness.
- Communion—we receive God's grace.
- Mission—we live out our faith.

#### Characteristics of Worship

Divine Interaction  
Community Participation  
Dedicated Attention

"Don't let them waste their time in endless discussion of myths and spiritual pedigrees. These things only lead to meaningless speculations, which don't help people live a life of faith in God. The purpose of my instruction is that all believers would be filled with love that comes from a pure heart, a clear conscience, and genuine faith. But some people have missed this whole point." 1 Timothy 1:4-6a (NLT)

#### Why We Worship?

- God is worthy of our worship.
- We are created to worship.
- Worship is our response to God's grace.

"I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength to do his work. He considered me trustworthy and appointed me to serve him, even though I used to blaspheme the name of Christ. In my insolence, I persecuted his people. But God had mercy on me because I did it in ignorance and unbelief. Oh, how generous and gracious our Lord was! He filled me with the faith and love that come from Christ Jesus. This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: 'Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners'—and I am the worst of them all. But God had mercy on me so that Christ Jesus could use me as a prime example of his great patience with even the worst sinners. Then others will realize that they, too, can believe in him and receive eternal life. All honor and glory to God forever and ever! He is the eternal King, the unseen one who never dies; he alone is God. Amen." 1 Timothy 1:12-17 (NLT)

#### Why We Pray?

- We pray because God wants everyone to be saved.
- We pray because Christ died so that everyone can be saved.

"I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. This is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth. For, there is one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity—the man Christ Jesus. He gave his life to purchase freedom for everyone." 1 Timothy 2:1-6 (NLT)
