Week 2-Fear of Rejection

“For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity...but of power, love, and self-discipline.” 2 Timothy 1:7 NLT

Overcoming the Fear of Rejection...

- **Realize some people won't like you**

“Fear of man is a dangerous trap, but trusting in the Lord means safety.” Proverbs 29:25 NLT

“Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.” Matthew 10:28 NIV

- **Receive God's truth about you**

“See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are!” 1 John 3:1a NLT

“God chose us in Christ to be holy and blameless in God's presence before the creation of the world. God destined us to be his adopted children through Jesus Christ because of his love. This was according to his goodwill and plan.” Ephesians 1:4-5 CEB

- **Refocus on God's will for you**

“Obviously, I'm not trying to win the approval of people, but of God. If pleasing people were my goal, I would not be Christ's servant.” Galatians 1:10 NLT

Fear of Rejection...

Causes us to conform our lifestyle
Keeps us from speaking the truth
Prevents giving and receiving love
Leads to isolation and loneliness
Moves us towards unhappiness
Silences our sharing about Christ
Keeps us from spiritual maturity
