Week 4-Fear of the Future

Do not overly focus on the temporary.

- Pursue contentment instead of more stuff.
- Trust instead of worry.

- Heaven is the hope-filled reality for those who trust in Jesus.
 - A place of complete restoration. (Revelation 21)
 - A place of full reconciliation.
- Will you turn from Jesus or will you trust in Jesus?
 - Live without Christ now and die without Christ forever.
 - Die with Christ now and live with Christ forever.
- The way we live now declares what we believe about tomorrow.
 - Talk like this world is not your hope.
 - Live like this world is not your home.
