Unlearning Bad Habits That Smash Relationships

Week 1-Start at the Right Place

“Since you have been raised to new life with Christ, set your sights on the realities of heaven, where Christ sits in the place of honor at God’s right hand. Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth. For you died to this life, and your real life is hidden with Christ in God. And when Christ, who is your life, is revealed to the whole world, you will share in all his glory. So...” Colossians 3:1-5a (NLT)

Bad Habit #1-Putting your other relationships ahead of THE RELATIONSHIP.

- **Worship Jesus First.**

Jesus replied, “You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’” Matthew 22:37-29 (NLT)

Bad Habit #2-Trusting your “feelings” more than your commitments.

- **Listen to Jesus First.**

“So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other.” John 13:34 (NLT)

Bad Habit #3-Trying to change other people.

- **Listen to Jesus...Again.**

“This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you. There is no greater love than to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.” John 15:12-13 (NLT)

Go Deeper:

- How does worshipping Christ and healthy relationships go together? What happens when fail to worship?
- How does the culture describe love? How does it define love? How does this contrast from how Scripture describes and defines love?
- Read John 13:34-35. Jesus tells us to “love one another.” Jesus makes “love” into a verb. What are some ways you can actively love the people God has put around you?
- In order to truly show Christian love towards others, we must first receive Christ’s love. However, some people struggle with receiving His love. Why? In the face of such reasons, how can someone learn to receive the love of Christ?
- Pick your favorite verse from the outline and memorize it.
