“You too are being built to become a dwelling in which God lives by his spirit.” Ephesians 2:22

The Purpose of God’s Presence...

- The Holy Spirit comforts us.

“The church then had peace throughout Judea, Galilee, and Samaria, and it grew in strength and numbers. The believers were walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit” (Acts 9:31).

“And the Holy Spirit helps us in our distress. For we don’t even know what we should pray for, nor how we should pray. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words” (Romans 8:26).

- The Holy Spirit convinces us.

[Jesus said] “But it is actually best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Counselor won't come. If I do go away, he will come because I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convince the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment.” John 16:7-8 (NLT)

“But when the Father sends the Counselor as my representative—and by the Counselor I mean the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I myself have told you.” John 14:26-27 (NLT)

“So you should not be like cowering, fearful slaves. You should behave instead like God’s very own children, adopted into his family—calling him ‘Abba, Father.’ For his Holy Spirit speaks to us deep in our hearts and tells us that we are God’s children.” Romans 8:15-16 (NLT)

Our Response to God’s Presence...

- Do not resist the Holy Spirit.

“Do not stifle the Holy Spirit.” 1 Thessalonians 5:19 (NLT)

- Do not grieve the Holy Spirit.

“Do not bring sorrow to God’s Holy Spirit by the way you live.” Ephesians 4:30 (NLT)

- Be filled with the Holy Spirit.

“Do not be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, let the Holy Spirit fill you and control you.” Ephesians 5:18 (NLT)
