Week 3-The Power of the Spirit

“But when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, you will receive power...” Acts 1:8 (NLT)

- **The Holy Spirit empowers us for a holy life.**
  - Holy living is evidence of being spirit-filled.

“So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. For the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you through Christ Jesus from the power of sin that leads to death.” Romans 8:1-2 (NLT)

“You are not controlled by your sinful nature. You are controlled by the Spirit if you have the Spirit of God living in you...the Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you. And just as he raised Christ from the dead, he will give life to your mortal body by this same Spirit living within you. So dear brothers and sisters, you have no obligation whatsoever to do what your sinful nature urges you to do. For if you keep on following it, you will perish. But if through the power of the Holy Spirit you turn from its evil deeds, you will live.” Romans 8:9, 11-13 (NLT)

- **The Holy Spirit empowers us for a fruitful life.**
  - Fruitful living is evidence of being spirit-led.

“But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives, he will produce this kind of fruit in us: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.” Galatians 5:22-23 (NLT)

“A good tree can’t produce bad fruit, and a bad tree can’t produce good fruit. A tree is identified by its fruit. Figs never grow on thorn bushes, nor grapes on bramble bushes. A good person produces good things from the treasury of a good heart, and an evil person produces evil things from the treasury of an evil heart.” Luke 6:43-45 (NLT)

- **The Holy Spirit empowers us for a supernatural life.**
  - Spiritual gifts are evidence of being spiritually equipped.

“Now there are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but it is the same Holy Spirit who is the source of them all. There are different kinds of service in the church, but it is the same Lord we are serving. There are different ways God works in our lives, but it is the same God who does the work through all of us. A spiritual gift is given to each of us as a means of helping the entire church.” 1 Corinthians 12:4-7 (NLT)

“God has given gifts to each of you from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Manage them well so that God’s generosity can flow through you.” 1 Peter 4:10 (NLT)
