Steps to Making Peace

- **Call a peace conference**

Matthew 5:23-24 “²³ Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, ²⁴ leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift.” (NIV)

- **Empathize with the feelings of others**

Philippians 2:4 “not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.” (NIV)

- **Plant a peace seed**

Romans 12:18 “If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.” (NIV)

James 3:18 “Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.” (NIV)

- **Pray for the person**

Matthew 5:44-45 “⁴⁴ But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ that you may be children of your Father in heaven....” (NIV)

- **Make peace with God**

Romans 5:1 “Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ” (NIV)
