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# Frazer Student Ministry Standards

## PDA POLICY

Frazer Student Ministry events are not dates and are not to be treated as such. Guys and girls are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that honors Christ and their parents.

1. There is to be absolutely no guys in girls' rooms or girls in guys' rooms.
2. We will not allow guys and girls sitting in each others' laps.
3. There will be no "laying on" or "snuggling" during bus rides or at events.
4. During nighttime trips, guys and girls sitting together must have an overhead light on. If no overhead light is available, opposite sexes will not sit together.
5. Guys and girls will not be allowed to share blankets or covering while traveling or at events.

These standards are very important to us. If any student breaks any of the above standards, the Frazer Student Staff has the right to send the student home via parent/guardian transportation. No refunds will be given.

# The Top Ten

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- 10. Students will meet at the church at 5:30 PM. Check in at the main Fellowship Hall. Dinner will be provided.** Stay in the Fellowship Hall until it is time to load the bus. We will leave Frazer no later than 6:15 PM.
- 9.** We will be traveling to Talladega, AL by Capital Trailways Charter Buses. There is no designated late travel service. Those students who have a conflict are responsible for their own transportation. Students are not allowed to drive. **If there is a need for late arrival or early pick up, details must be communicated to the Frazer Student Staff prior to Wednesday, February 15.**
- 8.** We will be staying at Shocco Springs Baptist Convention Center in Talladega, AL. Students will be in hotel style housing with 3-4 students per room. Rooming assignments are determined by the Frazer Student Staff based on grade, gender, and rooming requests made at the time of registration.
- 7.** One luggage bag will be allowed. See below for a list of what to bring. Cell phones will be allowed, **but they are the responsibility of the student.**
- 6. Luggage must be dropped off at the Frazer Student Ministry office on Wednesday, February 14, between 8 AM and 7 PM. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Luggage will be taken to Shocco Springs on Thursday morning. Students can bring a carryon bag for the bus on Friday.
- 5.** No extra money is required for the weekend. However, The Museum will have their merchandise for sale.
- 4. Students will not be allowed to leave their rooms after the designated lights-out time. Students who leave their room will have a parent called.** Please go over the standards with your student. Those who choose not to abide by the standards will be sent home at the parent's expense.
- 3.** Various free-time options will be available for students on Saturday afternoon. Options will include paintball, high-ropes, bazooka ball and more. No pre-registration is required.
