## UNBIND US AND LET US GO

${ }^{438}$ So Jesus, again being deeply moved within, came to the tomb. Now it was a cave, and a stone was lying against it. ${ }^{39}$ Jesus said, "Remove the stone." Martha, the sister of the deceased, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there will be a stench, for he has been dead four days." ${ }^{40}$ Jesus *said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?" ${ }^{41}$ So they removed the stone. Then Jesus raised His eyes, and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me. ${ }^{42}$ I knew that You always hear Me; but because of the people standing around I said it, so that they may believe that You sent Me." ${ }^{43}$ When He had said these things, He cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth." 44 The man who had died came forth, bound hand and foot with wrappings, and his face was wrapped around with a cloth.
